

In Brief - Domestic Aviation News

December 2010

Below is a brief of domestic news and updates received from Australian domestic and regional airlines servicing Queensland.



- From 10 December Jetstar will commence a new, daily Perth-Brisbane service. The airline will also introduce a third daily service on the Melbourne-Brisbane route and provide an additional two flights per week from Sydney to Townsville, bringing it to a daily service. These changes will add over 2,800 seats to Queensland's domestic schedule.
- Jetstar has also announced it will begin operating a new route. From 22 December, the airline will commence daily services from Hobart to the Gold Coast.



- Qantas will reintroduce capacity to its Hobart-Brisbane route. The twice-weekly flights commence on 12 December and will provide 288 additional seats to Brisbane's domestic capacity each week.
