

In Brief - Domestic Aviation News February 2012

Below is a brief of domestic news and updates received from Australian domestic and regional airlines servicing Queensland:



- Virgin Australia announced additional capacity into Queensland increasing capacity by 2,444 seats per week, comprising:
 - 6 Extra Brisbane – Cairns services per week from 13 February 2012, increase seat capacity by 760 seats per week.
 - An extra Brisbane – Gladstone service per week from 19 February 2012, increase seat capacity by 68 seats per week.
 - 7 extra Brisbane – Melbourne services per week from 13 February 2012, increase seat capacity by 532 seats per week.
 - 5 extra Brisbane – Rockhampton services per week from 20 February 2012, increase seat capacity by 584 seats per week.
 - 5 extra Brisbane – Whitsunday Coast (Proserpine) services per week from 13 February 2012, increase seat capacity by 500 seats per week.



- Jetstar announced additional capacity into Brisbane, Cairns and the Gold Coast increasing capacity by 3,240 seats per week, comprising:
 - 3 extra Melbourne–Brisbane services per week from 1 April 2012
 - 4 extra Melbourne–Cairns services per week from 1 April 2012
 - 4 extra Melbourne–Gold Coast services per week commenced 22 December 2011
 - An extra daily Sydney – Gold Coast service from 1 April 2012



- Tiger Airways Australia has added extra flights on existing Australian domestic routes to cater for demand and seasonality. Over 46,000 additional seats between Melbourne and Gold Coast and more than 28,000 seats between Melbourne and Brisbane have been put on for the new season travel period from 26 March to 27 October 2012.
