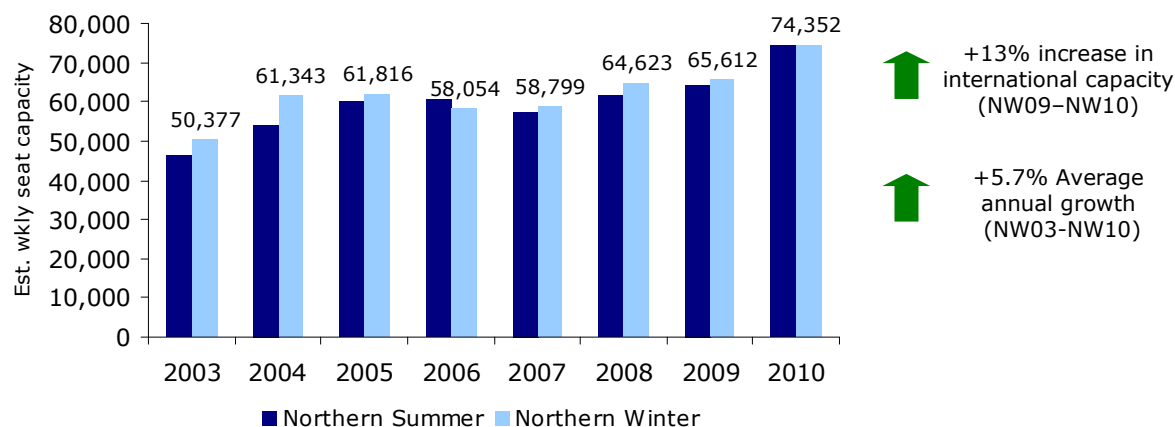
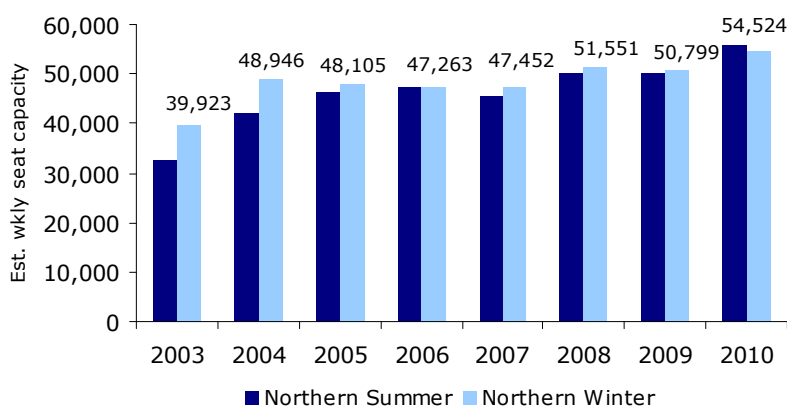


International Capacity to Queensland Airports

International Seats to Brisbane Airport

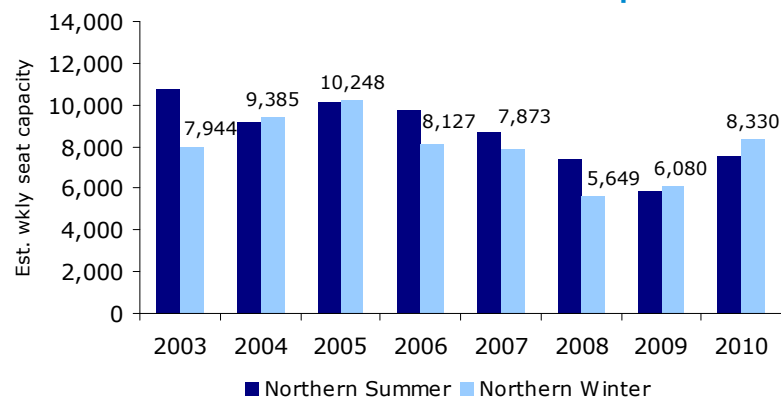


Brisbane – Capacity Changes

Up 7% compared with NW 2009; 4.6% average annual growth (2003-2010)

- China Southern commenced a 3-times weekly service from Guangzhou to Brisbane. These are the first direct scheduled services from China in over a decade and provide Queensland with 792 international weekly seats.
- Korean Air added an extra Seoul-Brisbane flight to its schedule, bringing their schedule up to six per week.
- Emirates will introduce the larger Boeing 777-300-ER onto its Dubai-Brisbane-Auckland route from January, increasing capacity by 672 weekly seats.
- Strategic Airlines will commence a twice-weekly service to Denpasar (Bali) via Townsville on 3 December 2010.
- Malaysia Airlines now have 5 non-stop services per week from Kuala Lumpur, whereas previously, the airline operated 7 services, 5 of which ran via Sydney.
- Japan Airlines withdrew from the Tokyo-Brisbane route on 1 October 2010.
- Philippine Airlines has withdrawn services from Manila.
- V-Australia's Phuket-Brisbane service will cease from February 2011.

International Seats to Cairns Airport

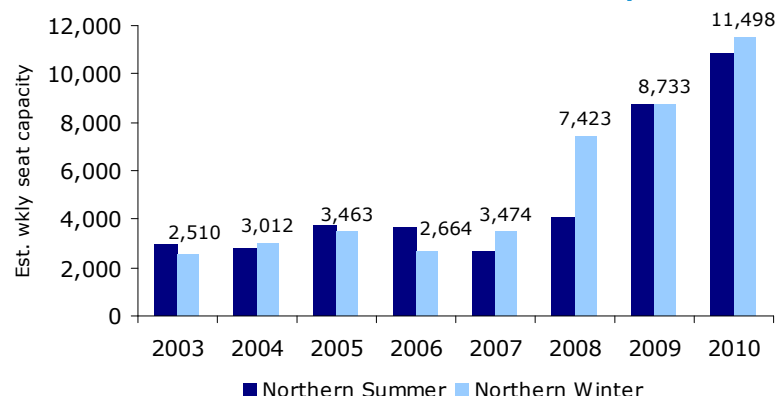


Cairns – Capacity Changes

Up 37% compared with NW 2009; 0.7% average annual growth (2003-2010)

- Cathay Pacific Airways have added an extra flight from Hong Kong to Cairns via Brisbane.
- Continental Airlines will reduce its frequency on the Guam-Cairns route from 4 to 2 services per week.
- QantasLink have introduced 12 flights per week from Cairns to Port Moresby utilising Dash 8 Q-400 aircraft which contribute over 880 seats to the region.

International Seats to Gold Coast Airport



Gold Coast – Capacity Changes

Up 32% compared with NW 2009; 24.3% average annual growth (2003-2010)

- Jetstar will commence a new, twice-weekly service from Queenstown to the Gold Coast from 17 December 2010, providing an additional 354 seats to the region.
