Daydream Island

Daydream Island Resort and Spa is a small but dynamic resort located in the heart of the Great Barrier Reef. Nestled among the Whitsunday Islands, it offers affordable luxury for couples and families alike. Its natural attributes – secluded beaches, azure waters and stunning rainforest – are complimented by a diverse range of fun-filled holiday activities, magical dining experiences and contemporary facilities, including a world-class rejuvenation day spa.

Activities

You need only take a few steps off the island to go snorkelling on the World Heritage-listed Great Barrier Reef – or you can witness many of its wonders right in the resort. Unique to Daydream is the man-made outdoor aquarium, a complex and stunning network of reef lagoons, containing over 40 marine fish species (including colourful clownfish, made famous in the Disney animated feature film Finding Nemo) and 50 coral varieties.

For active types, the fun begins with sail boarding, jet skiing, parasailing, coral viewing, reef fishing and scuba diving, and just keeps going with activities such as tennis, volleyball and badminton. Budding golfer's can practise their putting skills on the 19-hole themed mini golf course while nature lovers can enjoy a leisurely rainforest walk.

Spend the day lazing by the lagoon-style swimming pools and spas then catch the latest Hollywood blockbuster alfresco-style – on the outdoor cinema's 44-foot movie screen.

When it comes to food, Daydream offers an array of restaurants and tropical bars to satisfy every appetite. The island's signature restaurant, Mermaids, offers upmarket dining while families are well catered for with buffet-style dining at Waterfalls Restaurant, casual à la carte at the Fishbowl Tavern or deli-style at the Boathouse Bakery.

For parents in need of respite, the island also has a child-care facility at its Skipper's Club.

A mecca for romantics, Daydream provides the ideal setting for a private island wedding or commitment ceremony – either on the secluded beach at Lovers Cove or in the glass-fronted Endeavour Wedding Chapel.

Regular flights are available from Cairns, Brisbane, Sydney and Melbourne to Great Barrier Reef Airport (Hamilton Island) and Whitsunday Coast Airport (Proserpine). Fantasea Cruises and Cruise Whitsundays provide regular transfers from Hamilton Island (35 minutes), Abel Point Marina (20 minutes) and Shute Harbour (15 minutes) to Daydream Island. Shute Harbour is located approx 10 kilometres from Airlie Beach.
