## South Molle Island

Cradled between the Great Barrier Reef and the Queensland coast, South Molle Island rests in the heart of the spectacular Whitsunday Passage. Known as “the friendly island”, South Molle is a charming, relaxing environment to escape everyday life for a true island holiday in an unspoilt national park setting. Palm-fringed beaches and sheltered turquoise waters are complemented by the resort’s facilities, which include a restaurant, tennis court, swimming pool and nine-hole golf course.

### Activities

Go snorkeling and swimming at one of the many easily accessible bays and inlets or explore the island on foot. With 16 kilometres of scenic tracks traversing the national park, there’s a walk to suit every fitness level. A hike to the summit of Mount Jeffrey’s – the island’s highest point – offers a sensational 360° view of the Whitsunday Islands and the mainland.

Get up close and personal with colourful rainbow lorikeets – and a host of tropical fish – at the daily bird and fish-feeding sessions. Hire a dinghy and go fishing in a secluded bay. Get physical with a variety of water sports, including doughnut rides, waterskiing, catamaran sailing and windsurfing. Or take a break from the sun and sand and give yourself over to the healing delights of a Lomi Lomi massage.

Explore one of the region’s most acclaimed reef sites – Knuckle Reef Lagoon – aboard a scheduled cruise vessel (day trip) or take to the sky for a scenic helicopter flight over the reef and islands. Or just laze by the freshwater swimming pool. Then finish the day with a sunset cruise with all the trimmings: champagne, cheese and biscuits.

South Molle offers scheduled daily activity programs that any ages can get involved in. And when the sun goes down, you can watch the latest release movies on the big screen in the Discovery Bar, ham it up in the resort’s karaoke talent quest, or sit back and be entertained with easy listening acoustic music (Saturday nights).

### Style of accommodation

Affordable and comfortable, the units at South Molle Island Resort capture the relaxed tropical atmosphere of the island. Families are well catered for – the resort has dedicated Family Rooms as well as many units with interconnecting rooms.





### Beachcomber Rooms

Beachcomber Rooms are freestanding bungalows located right on the beach. With one queen and one double futon bed, the rooms sleep up to three people and have ensuite bathrooms with spa baths. All Beachcomber rooms have private balconies with water views

### Whitsunday Rooms

Whitsunday Rooms are located in a two-storey block right on the beachfront in the centre of the resort. These rooms sleep up to four people with one queen, one single and one rollaway bed, and have ensuite bathrooms with full baths. All Whitsunday rooms have a balcony or patio with water views. Interconnecting rooms are available.

### Reef Rooms

Reef Rooms are set in tropical gardens second row from the beachfront. These rooms sleep up to four people with one double, one single and one rollaway bed, and have ensuite bathrooms. All Reef rooms have a balcony or patio. Interconnecting rooms are available.

### Family Rooms

Family Rooms are set in tropical gardens overlooking the South Molle Island Golf Course. These rooms sleep up to six people (minimum of two adults and two children) with one double, two singles and one bunk bed, and have ensuite bathrooms. A sliding door divides the room. All Family rooms have a balcony or patio.

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## Access

Regular flights are available from all Australian capital cities (some via Brisbane) to Proserpine (Whitsunday Coast) Airport and Hamilton Island Airport. From Proserpine Airport, guests are transferred by coach to Abel Point Marina where they board the Cruise Whitsundays launch for a short cruise to South Molle Island Resort. From Hamilton Island Airport, guests also reach South Molle via a Cruise Whitsundays vessel.
