Whether it's a romantic weekend away or a month-long holiday, Queensland offers some fantastic destinations that are exclusive to couples. Enjoy time out with your partner at retreats as varied as stunning island resorts, mountain retreats or quaint rainforest B&Bs. Here are just some of the tempting Queensland getaways available:

Tropical North Queensland islands aplenty

Tropical North Queensland boasts a string of stunning island resorts to choose from, but if you're looking for a couples-only experience, head to the luxurious Orpheus or Lizard Islands.

For a Robinson-Crusoe style getaway, you can't go past Wilson Island - an exclusive island retreat for a maximum of just 12 guests. Accommodation is in one of six designer-inspired tents which sit right on the beach, while all meals are catered for by the onsite chefs.
